



BANNED FESTIVAL ITEMS

Alcohol (There are bars at the festival)

Illegal drugs

Glass (Including perfume bottles)

Fireworks, flares, fire twirling paraphernalia

Metal water bottles or Cans

Skateboards · Boogie boards · Scooters

Chairs (Small camp chairs are ok)

Milk/bread crates

Weapons (Sharp objects of any kind)

Containers of liquid fuel

Laser lights

Professional Cameras (small still cameras are okay)

Video and audio recording devices, including drones (other than mobile phones)

Umbrellas (use a plastic poncho or a raincoat instead, available at the info tent)

Water pistols

Protest paraphernalia and banners

Strictly no animals (with the exception of approved service of assisted animals, such as guide dogs)

Food (Please leave the cut lunch at home. If you have special dietary requirements and must bring a specific food or diet item, please email hello@big-pineapplefestival.com to arrange. However, the chances are we will have it covered by one of our food outlets. There are vegetarian, vegan and gluten free options available at the food stalls.)

BANNED CAMP GROUND ITEMS

GAS BOTTLES and COOKERS

DANGEROUS ITEMS
